

# **COUNTDOWN**

to the next CfaN Gospel Campaign 8 – 11 November 2018

We're just a few short weeks away from our next CfaN Great Gospel Campaign, taking place in Port Harcourt, Nigeria. It's not the first time we've been to this bustling, industrial city. In fact, CfaN has a long history with this place, and each time we've been there, God has multiplied His blessing, bringing literally millions to salvation. The numbers of decisions for Jesus, as well as the enormous crowd sizes, are almost mind-boggling. But the work there is certainly not yet done.

It has now been 14 years since CfaN was last there, and the population of the city has more than doubled. We believe that now is the time for harvest once again, and that "the latter glory of this house shall be greater than the former, says the Lord of hosts." (Haggai 2:9)



Port Harcourt has always been an industrial town, founded in 1912 as a port to export coal from the region. In 1956, crude oil was discovered in commercial quantities at Oloibiri, and the first shipment of Nigerian crude oil was exported through the city in 1958. It is a major industrial center with many multi-national companies, particularly businesses related to the petroleum industry, and is the chief oil-refining city in Nigeria. Thanks to oil, Rivers State is one of the wealthiest states in Nigeria in terms of gross domestic product, but for the average person, poverty, unemployment and crime are a fact of life.



## **POPULATION**

Currently, the Port Harcourt greater urban area has an estimated population of almost 3.1 million inhabitants, up from 1.4 million in 2006. This makes it one of the largest metropolitan areas in Nigeria, the most populous country in Africa. As the only major city in the region, it is highly congested. Incredibly, around 60% are under 19 years of age.

The people from Rivers State are collectively known as "Riverians", but they have many ethnic groups and languages, as well as a large migrant population.






## **CHRISTIANITY**

The first church in Port Harcourt came about in 1909, when some itinerant fishermen and traders came into contact with mission churches in outlying villages, and brought home what they had seen and heard. This region is known as "Christian", but ancestor worship, animism and witchcraft still have a strong hold on many people, and are often considered to simply be a part of the traditional culture. Churches that are working together for this campaign include a wide range of denominations, who stand with us to preach the unaltered, pure Gospel of Jesus Christ.

# Blessings in Brazzaville, Congo

## REPORT

9 - 12 August 2018

When God laid it on our hearts to go to Brazzaville in the Republic of the Congo, we knew that preparations for this campaign would be tough, situated as it is in the heart of Central Africa. But when the Lord says to go, we go. The challenges the technical team faced to get our equipment there were astonishing. In Evangelist Daniel Kolenda's words, the team "narrowly escaped death a couple of times. There were shootouts on the road. They crossed active war zones. They showed us a video of bullets flying inches from their cars, as armed guards were leading them through war zones. That's what it took to get to this place."

The many obstacles forced a delay of a month, but that only increased the anticipation, and there was no stopping what God had planned for this beautiful city.

# IN THE MOUTHS OF MANY WITNESSES

Right from the first meeting on Thursday night, God moved in a spectacular way, especially in healings, some of which we heard about over the next few days as people came forward to testify publicly. Again and again, we heard, "I was healed on Thursday night, and I waited to see if my healing was real."



One such man told us he had been injured when a wall collapsed on him, and in the first meeting, he was healed - but he waited for the final meeting to be sure, and gave his testimony with great joy, convinced of the power of God.



Another was a young lady with a lung disease, who had recently been to the doctor and had received X-Rays and a doctor's report confirming her disease. After she felt the power of God come over her body on Thursday, all pain left. She went back to the doctor the next day, and he took more X-Rays and did more tests. He said he could find no trace of her sickness and gave her a clean bill of health. On Saturday night, she brought her doctor with her, and he confirmed her healing in front of everyone.



Once again, our tech team faced lifethreatening challenges on the way back to Nigeria, including driving through a hail of bullets in a war zone. **Thank you for praying for their safe return.** 

## A GREAT GATHERING

The local pastors, bishops and police reported that these meetings were the largest ever seen in their country – larger even than the most important political rallies. The event caught the attention of those in the highest places of power, so that the President's wife invited Evangelist Kolenda, together with Rev. Peter Vandenberg (Vice President of CfaN) and John Darku (the African Director for CfaN) to visit the state palace for fellowship and prayer.

With tens of thousands of decisions made for Jesus, and new converts already being ushered into local churches and fellowships, Brazzaville has felt the unforgettable touch of God.

For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
