



The CfaN School of Evangelism draws people from all over the world. This one was no exception. I was aware that this was something special from the moment we walked in the door and were surrounded by the music of different accents and languages as people hugged one another and introduced themselves. The air was electric with excitement and expectation.

From near and far, young and not so young, it was obvious that here was a group of people who had felt a definite prompting of the Holy Spirit to come to a place where they would be encouraged and empowered in their calling to be evangelists. These were people committed to "Go into all the world and preach the Gospel!" Very often evangelism is treated like an optional extra in the life of a church, so to be with others of like mind is both encouraging and empowering.

Peter Vandenberg, Executive Vice President of the ministry, had this to say about why CfaN has a School of Evangelism: "SoE has actually existed for many years – about 35 in fact – but the format right now is the most effective it has ever been. We have it because we believe the ministry goes forward on two legs: one is preaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the unsaved, and the other leg is enabling, helping and instructing others to do the same. That is what the School is all about – multiplication of this vital ministry."
