ur most recent CfaN Gospel Campaign in Kisumu, Kenya, was marked by a very special manifestation of the presence of God. No matter how long and how often we do this work – preaching the Gospel, leading people to salvation, praying for the sick – we are still left in awe at the faithfulness and kindness of God. When we preach the simple Gospel message, God shows up! When we point the way to Jesus, He does what He has promised to do, always. He saves, He heals, He delivers. And He pours out His Spirit on every hungry heart who calls on His name.

A JOYFUL WELCOME IN THE STREETS

It was less than five weeks after our last campaign in Kenya, and just a few days after the amazing "Light the Fire Again" event in Pensacola, and we were back in Kenya for another campaign, this time in Kisumu, an important city in the far west of Kenya. What a welcome we received! Our arrival in Kisumu was marked by an overwhelming reception from the local church and a parade through the streets of Kisumu.

It has been more than 30 years since the last CfaN campaign in Kisumu, and with a whole new generation now grown up since then, there was a great harvest in waiting. As the team arrived, some of the local church leaders told Evangelist Daniel Kolenda that they had been praying for

someone to come and help them. Other evangelists had been discouraged from coming, due to security concerns, but we believed with all our hearts that the Lord had sent us for such a time as this.


THE POWER OF PRAISE

We were blessed to be joined in Kisumu by Eddie James and his worship group, leading the crowd in praising the name of Jesus. Worship is such an important part of the campaign meetings. The ministry of the Holy Spirit is not restricted to the preaching. Many times, it is during the worship that people are convicted of sin, or receive their physical healing. As the sound of praise rings out, people are freed from demonic oppression, and often run forward to bring charms and witchcraft items to be burned. Having a worship team who are sensitive to the leading of the Holy Spirit is vital.

HEARTS BURNING TO SERVE – THE FIRE CONFERENCE

Why do we have a Fire Conference with every major campaign? To teach and inspire the pastors and church leaders who will soon be coping with the influx of new converts in their churches. It's a time of intense teaching, focused on the work of the Holy Spirit, equipping people in ministry to step out into their callings.

In Kisumu, Rev. Peter Vandenberg and Rev. John Darku ministered to several hundred leaders, preaching the Word from Ezekiel and 2 Kings 2. The 3-day course finished with Evangelist Daniel Kolenda praying for the baptism in the Holy Spirit, and laying hands on people – sending them out to disciple and lead others in Kisumu.







THE TANGIBLE PRESENCE OF GOD

On the Saturday night, Daniel Kolenda preached two messages – first, he gave the salvation message, and then he spoke about the baptism in Holy Spirit. What happened next is best described in his own words:

On Saturday night, we had an incredible move of God. It is hard for me to adequately describe what happened. When we prayed over the crowd to receive a baptism in the Spirit, the power of God came down in a tangible way. I became so inebriated, I found it difficult to minister. Bodies lay all over the ground. Little children were weeping in the presence of God. I asked a little girl what she was feeling and she said, "Power." Many received deliverance from demons and many miracles happened."

Healing and deliverance, in Jesus' name!

There were so many healings, it was hard to document them all, but here are some that stood out to us...

- A woman who had to be helped by 3 friends to walk to the campaign danced on stage, accompanied by a friend who confirmed her complete healing
- A woman whose mother had been insane since 1989 said that she had returned to her right mind
- Daniel had a word of knowledge about someone being healed from an abscess on the right side of their mouth. Two ladies came forward. One had the abscess and severe swelling and pain for over a year and the other for two months. Both were instantly healed, the swelling and pain vanished.

Those who have partnered with us for years know that the weather is an ever-important topic for us. Although there is less rain at this time of year in equatorial Africa, it still rains! And the power of an equatorial thunderstorm is something to behold. Whether or not it rains is of vital importance in every single African campaign. Not only can a rainstorm clear the field, and prevent us preaching the Gospel, it is also dangerous for our equipment. So we take praying for good weather very seriously indeed.

Evangelist Kolenda shared this from the last night in Kisumu: "As we were driving toward the field tonight, we could see ominous black clouds and lightning threatening our open air meeting. The wind was blowing the storm toward the campaign, but we prayed and pushed forward with the meeting. The storm passed over us and everyone stayed dry. The meeting was glorious. Many thousands responded to the Gospel and wonderful miracles happened."

Just as in the previous campaign in Nakuru, we saw that "even the wind and waves obey His voice" – and nothing can stop what God has ordained.

FROM EAST TO WEST

Right now, the CfaN team is – only days after finishing our last campaign in Abeokuta – once again on the road, heading for the final event of 2019 in Ado Ekiti. Please continue to pray for the team, and believe with us for a wonderful result in those cities.
