

A historic milestone for CfaN

For the first time in the history of the ministry we have successfully initiated five simultaneous mass Gospel Campaigns in five different cities. As you can probably imagine, the logistical undertaking to execute this was enormous! This is how it worked...

The five cities we went to were **Tunduma, Iringa, Morogoro, Dodoma and Mbeya**. These cities fit perfectly in the Decapolis strategy – smaller towns where our supermassive Gospel Campaign machine could never afford to go. In the past, we only had one “tool” in our evangelistic “toolbox” – a massive campaign sledgehammer. It was very big and could only be used in certain contexts. Now, in addition to the supermassive “Flagship Campaigns” which we are still doing, we have a new strategy that allows us to reach smaller, more remote, and unreached places with the Gospel while continuing to have a massive impact!

The **Operation Decapolis** campaigns in each city ran from Wednesday to Sunday, five nights each. If you are wondering how we could do this, it is because of the “multiplication” initiative we have been busy with for several years now.

In each city, two guest evangelists preached two nights each. Most of these preachers are graduates of our Evangelism Bootcamp! Evangelist Daniel Kolenda preached one night in each city, traveling each day to the next ongoing campaign.

Here is just a tiny taste of the magnificent move of God in Tanzania!



Tunduma

Tunduma was the first city Evangelist Daniel Kolenda preached in for Operation Decapolis, on Day One. Evangelists David Rotärmel and Michael Job preached on the other four nights.

This baby had never walked in his entire life! When Evangelist Michael Job prayed, the mama laid hands on her baby as the preacher had instructed – and he suddenly got up and started walking. They were the first steps he'd ever taken.

“ There was such an excitement and anticipation of what God was going to do on the field Friday night. The people were hungry and listening to every word spoken. I preached about the power of the blood of Jesus to a crowd of over 45,000 people. **Over one third of the population of the entire city came out to hear the Gospel that night.** ”

“ The city was heaving with excitement. As I sat in my room before the meeting, I could hear “sound cars” driving through the streets, making announcements. I couldn't understand the language except for one word: “Kolenda.” They were announcing over and over the arrival of our team and the campaign starting tonight. **I could not wait to preach and tell the people that Kolenda cannot save them. I did not come here for them to learn the name Kolenda. I came to proclaim the name above every other name, the name of Jesus! The city was filled with thousands of shouts as they cried out in unison “Jesus, Jesus, Jesus!”** ”

In each city, we also have Bootcamp students who have been working here for the last 6 weeks helping to organize the campaign. On Day One, those stationed in Tunduma officially graduated and Peter Vandenberg and I presented them with their diplomas and rings in front of the tens of thousands present.

“ After the preaching of the Gospel, I taught briefly on healing the sick, and as I began praying for the sick, miracles started breaking out everywhere. I've been to quite a few campaigns by now, but this time **it was unlike anything I've ever seen with my own eyes.** Like in CfaN footage that I've only seen on videos, crutches were being lifted into the air all over the place and the lame began to walk. The whole crowd was going crazy and started shouting and celebrating. Miracles upon miracles began breaking out EVERYWHERE my eye could see! ”

Iringa

Dr. Daniel King and Dr. Roselyne Ayeola were the evangelists in Iringa, where Daniel Kolenda joined them on Day Two.

“ After preaching a clear Gospel message and seeing many thousands respond, together with the interns, we prayed for the sick and amazing miracles took place.

- A woman with painful tumors on both sides of her waist (the size of a fist) said **the tumors instantly vanished** during prayer, and all pain is gone.
- An elderly woman testified that she took a bad fall several months ago, which left her paralyzed on the left side of her body and unable to speak. After prayer, the paralysis completely left, and her speech returned. When I asked her if she had any lingering effects from the paralysis, she said that there was only a slight numbness on the left side. I prayed for her again and right there on the platform, all remaining numbness left, and she was made completely whole!

“ As a young African female evangelist trained by Evangelist Daniel Kolenda at the CfaN Evangelism Bootcamp, I had the precious privilege of preaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ on African soil on a mass scale. In Iringa, **I preached on the power in the blood of Jesus**, and for the first time in my life, I saw almost every hand go up in response to the call for salvation. I am still blown away by the breakthroughs I witnessed.

A little boy named Godwin couldn't walk for 2 months. After I prayed for the sick on Day 3, he began to walk. I asked if he could dance and he said he didn't know how to. How precious! I told him I would dance with him, and together we danced and sang praises to Jesus.

Morogoro

In this city – the third stop for Evangelist Kolenda – it was Evangelists Jared Horton and Evelina Smane who proclaimed the Gospel and prayed for the sick, seeing thousands come to Jesus.



Up on stage, **pastors all around me wept** as they witnessed this supernatural outpouring of miracles happening before their eyes. Once you've seen that, it changes you forever!

Andrew was one of the first to testify on stage. His friends brought him to the campaign on a motorcycle and gently placed him on the ground, and there he lay, flat on his back, waiting for a miracle from the Lord. He hadn't been able to walk for six months, and was numb in his back and legs. But when I prayed for the sick, Andrew said he felt a surge of power enter his body. Not only was he completely healed in an instant – he also received Jesus and went home a completely changed man.

As soon as I arrived on the final night of the campaign, I could see straight away that the crowd was much bigger than the previous nights. Before I walked up on the platform, the local Campaign Organizer told me that the pastors of Morogoro said **it was the largest crowd gathering for a Gospel Campaign in the history of Morogoro, Tanzania!**

Anna Ataringa had so much pain in her legs and waist that she couldn't sit properly for five years. She was going to go to a hospital, but her friend told her about the campaign in Morogoro and she decided to go there instead. Dodoma

The campaign in Dodoma was in full swing when Evangelist Daniel Kolenda arrived on Saturday – Holy Spirit Night – to join Evangelists Joe Turnbull and Paul Maurer.

“ I felt a wonderful breakthrough took place. After preaching the Gospel, as soon as I began praying for the sick, demons started manifesting all over the field in extraordinary numbers. Our deliverance team had their hands full! **Then I asked the five interns who had been stationed in Dodoma for the last few weeks (and who also officially graduated that night) to help me minister to the sick. We saw many amazing miracles take place:**

- One man had a brace on his back. He used a cane to walk and had to use painkillers. He stopped using the cane and brace and was completely healed. He stomped all over the stage, showing how his back and legs had received strength.
- One woman had severe pain in her spine and had to use crutches. After prayer, she was running on stage, showing how she had been healed.
- For 22 years, another woman was not able to bend over because of the severe pain she was suffering from. Tonight, she was relieved from this pain; all her mobility was restored.
- A man also told us that on Wednesday he came to the campaign a severe alcoholic. On the Saturday, he testified that he had not had a drink since he was prayed for and was totally free.

“ As I shared stories and illustrations, there was joy and laughter. But there was also darkness, which was the message I preached tonight: to turn from darkness to light. Even in the middle of the preaching, demons were manifesting on the field. Many were being carried out. But as Evangelist Daniel Kolenda taught us, the devil can have no minute of the campaign. We pressed on and we preached the clear Gospel: that people must turn from the power of Satan to the power of God. As we got near to the end of the message, Jesus took control. When I gave the altar call, for a split second, I was nervous. Then all of a sudden, when I asked them to raise their hands, over a thousand people raised their hands, and in that moment, I knew that this is what I am called to do the rest of my life.

“ As I moved on to pray for the sick, I asked the crowd, **“How many of you believe that God is able to heal?”** Most of their hands went up. I explained further. “For most people, the question isn’t whether God is able to heal, but whether He is willing. When Jesus met the man who had leprosy, he cried out “Lord, if you are willing, you can make me clean.” And to this cry, Jesus replied, “I am willing, be clean” and instantly the man was cured.” We could see how people got excited, their faith level was built up and **many began to believe and press in for their miracle.** I prayed for the sick, and immediately people started coming forward with testimonies.

A young man who had been **completely deaf in his right ear for twenty years** came forward to tell his story. He came to the stage with his mother who verified that he truly had been deaf for all these years. He had been to the doctors, but they couldn’t give him any hope, nor help. But **Jesus was there to touch this young man and restore his hearing!** The crowd was roaring with joy and shouting “HALLELUJAH,” as we all celebrated Jesus and this incredible miracle. Earlier that night, this man and his mother had also given their lives to Jesus and received the gift of salvation. As he was being tested on the stage, **with a smile on his face he shouted out loud: “I love Jesus!”**

Mbeya

The two evangelists stationed in this city were Gary Smith and Daniel Garcia. Daniel Kolenda joined them in Mbeya to preach on the last night.

“ After the short graduation ceremony, I preached the Gospel, reiterating what the other two evangelists stationed in this city have preached each of the previous four nights and concluding with a short message about Jesus – the Resurrection and the Life! What a Holy Ghost party we had! But we didn’t just talk about the power of the resurrection as a past-tense, historical reality. 

One little boy who had a rare condition that took all the strength from his legs was able to walk for the first time in his life. I heard the voice of Jesus telling me to hug this little boy and tell him that Jesus was healing him. I asked him to walk and that is when the miracle happened. The little boy’s mom was weeping as she saw her little boy walking for the very first time. The crowd was jumping and celebrating with shouts of joy and praise to our Jesus!

I preached a simple but powerful message from Evangelist Daniel Kolenda using the story of Zacchaeus. This story reflects the heart of God for restitution – making the wrongs right. The crowd was engaged and expectant as this story is very captivating. I was sharing the moment when Jesus encounters Zacchaeus and deeply loves him and I noticed people crying all over the place as they encountered the beautiful forgiving love of Jesus.
