Then the most important thing that could ever happen to any of us happened! With tears in her eyes (and if I'm honest, mine too), this precious lady told the whole city of Jinja that "as my hearing returned, Jesus revealed Himself to me, and I have accepted Him as my Lord and Saviour."




NIGHT TWO

History being made!

In 1990, a CfaN crusade with Reinhard Bonnke here in Jinja, Uganda, was violently stopped by the military on orders of the then state governor. Reinhard Bonnke dusted the "dust off his shoes," in accordance with scripture, as we were chased away. Some months later, reports filtered in of failed rains in the region, economic failures, and the amazing fact that the governor concerned became insane and was removed from office.

Now in 2022, 32 years later, just before Randy Roberts preached the Gospel in the meeting on the very same campaign site as before, the minister of state for Uganda, who comes from this region, came to the campaign meeting officially to make a speech. The purpose of this speech was to repent before CfaN and God on behalf of the region and the government for what happened to us here and for their rejection of the Gospel in 1990. He knelt on the platform and asked us to release them by forgiveness. I took the microphone and accepted the repentance and publicly forgave them. The crowd went wild with jubilation, and it was deeply moving. Then we prayed for him and the people of Jinja. It was historic, heralding a new era of God's blessing for the land.








NIGHT Three

This was because they received Jesus as their Savior the night before and no longer believed the lies of the devil. Two large barrels near the platform were made ready with all the idols, amulets, and potions placed inside to be burnt with fire. As the flames flared up, great joy and jubilation broke out across the crowd, and worshippers streamed forward to dance in joy around the burning barrels. The atmosphere was filled with victory, deliverance, and joy.

NIGHT FOUR

From preaching to hundreds – to a hundred thousand!

I want to thank Evangelist Daniel Kolenda for having a vision and the courage to follow that vision! Before I came to the Christ for all Nations Evangelism Bootcamp, the most people I had ever preached to was 2,500, and that was one time. I was always thankful for the crowds of 300 - 500 I would preach to, but I wanted to be more effective. Now, two years later, Peter Vandenberg and I just left a field with 100,000 people rejoicing for what Jesus had done in their city!

As Peter and I left the field last night, we knew God was moving mightily in Jinja. The campaign had been reported on in many newscasts, and we had received several communications from both local and national leaders because they had heard what was happening in Jinja. Yet, I was still overwhelmed when we arrived on the campaign field to a crowd that had almost doubled from the previous night! My heart was bursting watching these precious people dancing and rejoicing. I preached a simple Gospel message (that Evangelist Kolenda taught me) on the law of salvation, and thousands surrendered their lives to our King Jesus!

Nights of Hope

From 8 – 10 July, CfaN Bootcamp graduate Evangelist David Rotärmel led the "Nights of Hope" Gospel Campaign in the Black Forest region of Germany. This Gospel Campaign was

conducted in true CfaN style, with pre-campaign outreaches, close work with participating local churches, and no-holds-barred preaching of the pure Gospel. The results make it clear that the Gospel is the same for anyone in any country! God does not reserve salvation, healings and deliverance for Africa. People are hungry for Jesus everywhere.

Jesus showed up in a mighty way bringing salvation, healing, freedom, and establishing His Kingship over the land.

Over the span of three days, at the campaign nights in Schwenningen, over 600 individuals gave their "yes" to following Jesus. On the Saturday and Sunday, over 180 Christians were mobilized to do outreaches in different cities in the Black Forest and bring the lost to the campaign meetings.



JESUS ALWAYS SHOWS UP!

"Every day of the campaign, we witnessed what it looks like when Jesus shows up to meet those who are lost and broken and those who are hungry for more. Two young boys who received healing the last night prayed for a woman who was blind and her eyesight was restored. And on the Saturday night, a girl who was deaf for 18 years came on stage with her

hearing aid in hand because her ears were opened. That same night a man whose legs could not carry him crawled to the field. After prayer, he freely walked on stage and leapt with joy. Driving back to the hotel from the campaign field I realized that the miracles we have seen here in Germany were more astonishing than the things I have seen in crusades in Africa. No-one can say anymore "Why do miracles only happen in Africa and not in Europe?"

During the preparation phase of the campaign, our evangelists went from city to city in the Black Forest region declaring the Good News and introducing people to Jesus in the streets. On the streets with 15-20 evangelists constantly doing outreaches for over 6 weeks (54 outreaches in total), we saw over 996 people make decisions to receive.

On top of that, in those weeks 14 empowerment weekends were conducted, equipping Christians from multiple local churches of every zone of the region to preach the Gospel with boldness. Churches were also equipped in discipleship to be able to receive the new believers and strengthen them in their daily life with Jesus."

Gospel Town Festival

There's more than one way to reach the Gospel. Sometimes we invite people to come to a meeting. Sometimes, we need to take the Gospel to where the people are. This was the strategy God gave CfaN Bootcamp graduate Evangelist Lukas Repert, to reach the town of Bamberg.

Together with local churches, and a team of Bootcamp graduates, Lukas organized a weekend family festival in the town center of Bamberg from 29 – 31 July. With food trucks, Gospel singers on stage and plenty of children's activities to draw people in, the aim was to preach the Gospel every hour, on the hour. And that's exactly what they did! This was not preaching to a crowd of believers. These were people out doing their shopping, the vast majority of whom seldom – if ever – come to church events.

DON'T STOP WHEN IT GETS DIFFICULT!

"The outreach got off to a rough start on the Friday, when a huge storm blew up. But it's not the first time we've seen the Gospel proclaimed in the driving rain! Despite more rain on the second day, 58 people gave their lives to Jesus. Every time the Gospel was preached, we could see more

and more happening. Barriers were coming down, territory was being taken, in Jesus' name. By the time we got to the Saturday evening altar call and prayed for the sick, seeing miracles happening in front of our eyes, we knew that the final day was going to be special.

Sure enough, on Sunday – with the sun shining beautifully – we were inundated with visitors! We actually had to restrict entry at some moments, because the queues were so long. Every hour, we preached the Gospel, and saw over 200 decisions for Jesus in total. With over 5,000 visitors over the weekend, this was

an effective and productive way to reach people who wouldn't go to a "church meeting".
