She pushed through the crowd toward the front. Taking her hand, Daniel led her onto the platform and asked what happened. This woman lived on the outskirts of Hosanna and had traveled into town just for the campaign. Deaf in both ears for seven years, she said the moment he pointed at her, her ears popped open – she could hear! She danced and jumped across the platform, overcome with unrestrained joy.

Then, like a dam breaking, miracles erupted across the field. People fell to the ground in worship as a holy awe swept over us, gripping every heart.
